From the Desk of Fr. Francis

Greetings of Christ's Peace and Joy! Hope you all had a blessed week.

Renew My Church

Pope Francis' Apostolic Exhortation on *Love in the Family*, which I strongly encourage you to read, uses the metaphor of "the parish as a family of families" to help us to relate our family life to our parish

As you know, the Archdiocese of Chicago is going through *Renew My Church* process now. When Archbishop Blasé Cupich met with his priests two weeks ago, he presented to us his seven signs of a healthy parish in relation with seven signs of a healthy family. I share with you for your nourishment and reflection.

- 1. We (a mission -oriented parish) bring people to Christ.
 - *A healthy family brings life into the world.
- 2. We support each other in knowing Christ more deeply.
 - * A healthy family hands on and forms its members in a way of life.
- 3. We encourage Christ and receive nourishment through prayer and worship. *A healthy family is a place of nourishment.
- 4. We build bonds among each other to sustain our life in Christ.
 - *A healthy family is where members learn relational skills.
- 5. We transform the lives of others through service as Christ's missionary disciples. *A healthy family inspires members to make their lives count in the world.
- 6. We respond to the call to holiness by journeying together with Christ.
 - *A healthy family experiences wholeness and integrity of life by walking with its members through various stages of life.
- 7. We take responsibility and leadership of the parish as good stewards of the gifts Christ has entrusted to us.
 - *A healthy family is marked by stability and responsible leadership.

Like any analogy, the metaphor of "a parish as family of families" has its limitations, but it does help us to know more about our own families and to relate our family life with our parish life.

Faith and Elections

As the 2016 elections quickly approach, one of the questions we converse is whom are you going to vote? As Catholics, we know that we have to vote according to our conscience, which should be formed according to the principles and teachings of our Church, and we shouldn't separate our faith with the politics for we all have responsibilities toward our society. While the Church can't tell you whom to vote, but the Church does offer guidelines to help us to vote. "PRAY CONTINUALLY"

A few days ago, I read a story about a recent healing taking place at the Shrine to Mary, Our Lady of Lourdes, in Lourdes, France. A young woman was paralyzed due to a brain tumor. She was brought to the water which St. Bernadette discovered at the direction of Mary. Suddenly she stood, moved about, and seemed well. Such healings happen there on occasion. The Church will continue its study of the event to discover the authenticity of the healing. People must have been praying for this young woman. God seems to have heard her faith filled prayer.

Our readings today talk about prayer. Moses prays holding up his arms to God and when he becomes too tired, others help him hold up his extended arms. As long as Moses prays in this manner the Israelites win the battle they are fighting. When he puts his arms down, the Israelites begin to lose their battle.

Jesus tells the story of the judge who will give the widow the decision she requests, not because he wants to be just in deciding, but because she "keeps bothering me." Jesus tells us to see what the judge did and be persistent like the widow when we pray. God will hear our prayers just as the judge heard the woman's request. He is encouraging us to continue to ask and to seek God's help. It may not be in the way we want the answer or when we want the answer, but God does hear our prayer.

We will be celebrating the Sacrament of the **Anointing of the Sick next Sunday at the 9:30am Mass.** Encourage those Catholics who are usually homebound or struggling with serious illnesses, to come and be with us. We all will add our prayers to theirs for healing and strengthening. We believe God heals us and hears our prayers.




