Our visit to the Shrine of Our Lady of La Salette, located in Twin Lakes, Wisconsin, offers a day-long pilgrimage of peace and reflection.

The outdoor Shrine is a replica of the site of the apparition in France with seating for outdoor liturgies. Located close by are shrines that commemorate the apparitions of the Mother God, inviting us to ponder on the messages she gave to the visionaries.

The La Salette Missionaries minister in 23 countries around the world; they are best known for their compassion, willingness to listen and understand. In this fast-paced world, they provide a vital role - someone for a troubled person to talk to.

La Salette (La-sa-let) French words meaning "the little room", is also the name of a little French village nestled in the Alps where an extraordinary occurrence took place near the village on September 19, 1846.

Today, it is the site of a shrine built to celebrate an appearance of the Mother of Jesus to two children. It is holy ground for the Mother of God came to this remote area to invite all her children to the reconciling love of her Son, Jesus. It is a place of faith and prayer, a place of prophetic challenge to our time, a place of pilgrimage.



To Teach Who Christ Is---Kickoff Weekend

In honor of the vision set forth by Cardinal Francis George, O.M.I., and under the continued leadership of Archbishop Blase J. Cupich, I am pleased to announce that, following significant planning and prayerful reflection, the Archdiocese of Chicago has launched *To Teach Who Christ Is*, a \$350 million campaign for parishes, Catholic education and faith formation.

Working together in this campaign, we seek to:

- Complete our mission of Parish Transformation and focus on evangelization, Chinese Apostolate and formation.
- Provide scholarships to qualified students in Catholic schools in Cook and Lake Counties.
- Enhance the academic excellence of our Catholic schools.
- Create innovative new faith formation programs for children and adults, and train catechetical leaders.
- Address critical facility issues in churches and other parish buildings in economically challenged neighborhoods.

This campaign has six waves. St. Therese is in the last wave. It has been very successful overall. As the Archbishop says that this campaign is not only about raising funds, but more importantly it is a great opportunity for us to reflect on how we are passing down our faith. Literally it is about how we are to teach others about Jesus Christ.

I have been working with a group of our leaders, named *Campaign Executive Committee*, in the last few weeks. We have attended training sessions and have met several times with the campaign facilitator assigned to us by the Archdiocese.

This weekend, I am pleased to announce this campaign to all of you and invite you to help our parish to meet our goal of \$200,000 in pledge form over a five-year period. The good news is that we already have over 80 percent of our goal pledged. St. Therese will receive approximately 60 percent of the funds raised up to our campaign target, and 100 percent of the funds raised beyond our target for local needs.

You will receive more communications in the next few weeks. I ask you to please pray for the success of this campaign and to consider making a pledge in helping our parish to join in the campaign's success during the next few months.



"THE LITTLE WAY"

Many people look at their lives and think they are doing nothing or not much for God. They compare themselves to the saints who are martyrs or missionaries in foreign countries. They look at people who are saints who did extreme penances or were heroic in actions and suffering. They say they can never do these things so they could never be a saint.

Our parish patron saint is just the saint for all of us, especially those who see themselves as only capable of small actions. Saint Therese never went to a foreign land as a missionary even though she is the patron of the Missions. She never did big, important actions. Her way of life, her "little way", was a way of living, doing small and seemingly unimportant things. The secret to her holiness was WHY she did each action. She did EACH ACTION with as much love for God as she had at that moment. She offered everything to Jesus with love. She accepted slights and criticism with love. She did tasks assigned to her, offering their fulfillment with love. She showed kindness to others, doing all lovingly, as if Jesus were the person she was doing it to. She offered all to Jesus no matter what it was, with all the love she had.

Therese was born in 1873 in France. She entered the Carmelite Convent in Lisieux on April 9, 1888 at the age of 16. She died at the age of 24 after 11 years in religious life. Pope John Paul II declared her a Doctor of the Church. The story of her spiritual life was published and explains her way of loving and serving God. Her autobiography is called "The Story of a Soul."

We celebrate the Feast of Saint Therese today. She is the saint for us, for our parish. She is the one who teaches us that we too can be saints. All we have to do is do all the tasks of our daily life faithfully, offering them to God, with Jesus, because of our love for God. We can also be like Saint Therese, great saints, no matter how unimportant we may think we are. Before God, love makes us very great, holy people.

Vocal prayer consists in saying twenty decades of The Hail Mary, each decade headed by

an Our Father, while at the same time meditating on and contemplating the twenty principal virtues which Jesus and Mary practiced in the twenty mysteries of The Holy Rosary. So the Rosary is a blessed blending of mental and vocal prayer by which we honor and learn to imitate the mysteries and the virtues of the life, death, passion and glory of Jesus and Mary. For through the Holy Rosary:

Sinners are forgiven;
Souls that thirst are refreshed;
Those who are fettered have their bonds broken;
Those who weep find happiness;
Those who are tempted find peace;

The poor find help;

Religious are reformed;

Those who are ignorant are instructed;

The living learn to overcome pride;

The dead (The Holy Souls) have their pains eased by suffrages.

The Holy Rosary is the root and storehouse of countless blessings. (From 'The Secret of the Rosary,' St. Louis De Montfort)

In this time of confusion and world turmoil, saying the rosary will help comfort the evils of terrorism and Christian persecution.

We, as auxiliary members of the Legion of Mary of St. Therese Parish, recite the rosary daily to renew our lives in Christ and, in doing so, we have received bountiful graces, blessings and indulgences through it.
