When you obediently said "yes" in the house of Nazareth, you allowed God's eternal Son to take flesh in your virginal womb and thus to begin in history the work of our redemption.

You willingly and generously cooperated in that work, allowing the sword of pain to pierce your soul, until the supreme hour of the Cross, when you kept watch on Calvary, standing beside your Son, who died that we might live.

From that moment, you became, in a new way,

the Mother of all those who receive your Son Jesus in faith and choose to follow in his footsteps by taking up his Cross.

Mother of hope, in the darkness of Holy Saturday you journeyed with unfailing trust towards the dawn of Easter.

Grant that your children may discern at all times, even those that are darkest, the signs of God's loving presence.

Our Lady of Sheshan, sustain all those in China, who, amid their daily trials, continue to believe, to hope, to love.

May they never be afraid to speak of Jesus to the world, and of the world to Jesus.

In the statue overlooking the Shrine you lift your Son on high, offering him to the world with open arms in a gesture of love. Help Catholics always to be credible witnesses to this love, ever clinging to the rock of Peter on which the Church is built. Mother of China and all Asia, pray for us, now and for ever. Amen!

"BE NOT AFRAID"

Many people are very frightened of speaking in front of a group. When I first began teaching and we had parent meetings at the start of the school year, I was so afraid to speak that I was only willing to say my name. For two years the Sister I taught with in the other First grade, tried to get me to say more but I would only say my name. The third year I said more at the parent meeting. I worked many, many years at overcoming my fear until now I can speak much more easily in front of a group. People who hear me never believe I ever found it difficult. I now "take a deep breath" and trust the Holy Spirit to help me.

The Apostles in our Gospel today were still staying together in the upper room, still afraid. Jesus called them to the mountain and there, before He ascended to the Father, He gave them two commandments and made a promise. First He told them, "Go, therefore and make disciples of all nations." Secondly, Jesus said, "Baptize them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you." The promise He made to them and to us is, "I am with you always, until the end of the age." The apostles returned to Jerusalem, to the Upper room and waited for the coming of the Spirit. Then they courageously went out fulfilling what Jesus had told them to do.

The things Jesus told His apostles to do He is also telling us to do. We can be hesitant and maybe a little fearful to share our faith or to talk to other people inviting them to join us in being Catholic and believing what Jesus teaches even today through us and through the Church. We are the people here and now who are sent to share the teachings of Jesus and to share the witness of our beliefs in our lives. Join us in this evangelization effort, especially at our summer fair in July. We do not have to be afraid. We have the promise of Jesus to be with us always and we too have the gift of the Holy Spirit to help us, to strengthen and encourage us and to be in us. We are called to go into our world of Chinatown and the world of our everyday lives, and bring Jesus and His message to others. "Go" you too are sent. "I am with you always."
