



#### "IN OUR MIDST" ~Sister Caritas

If we look at our world today, and probably it always has been true, we see people coming together to accomplish a goal. In neighborhoods where there are problems, people find that they need to come together in block clubs or community action groups in order to change the dynamic in their area. By coming together, defining the problem, and working together to bring about the solution, things can change. When we come together to achieve something it can be a lot easier than "going it alone."

Our readings today give us instructions on how to "get along" as a member of humanity, a member of a family, a member of a community. In the Gospel today, the last sentence tells us something very important. "Where two or three are gathered together, in my name, there am I in the midst of them." We often may look for God in various places. We think we will find God in a special way of doing something, in saying a special prayer, or by going to a special place. All of these actions may help us to know God at some times. We believe Jesus is with us in the Holy Eucharist. We believe Jesus is always present in the tabernacle of our Church. Jesus tells us today, that if we gather together IN HIS NAME, He will be in our midst. If we gather together, in His name, in order to accomplish something, to solve a problem, to develop a new ministry, if we go together to reach out to others, if we pray together for the sick or the sinner, Jesus will be with us, in our midst.

Sometimes I hear people say, "Why do I have to come to Church? I can pray at home." If we act on the thing Jesus tells us today, we know that when we gather together to celebrate Mass in His Name, He is here with us. Jesus is in our midst, in the gathered community. When I was on a thirty day retreat, we seldom talked with the others also making the retreat, but we celebrated Eucharist and prayed together and for each other. There was a bond among us. Just about every morning here at St. Therese there is a group of us who come to the morning Mass. While we are a part of the larger St. Therese parish, this relatively small group has developed a bond and a caring for each other. It has also been my experience that this happens in other parishes too. Jesus becomes the reason we are together and the bond that joins us together. In your families and among your friends, come together in the name of Jesus and He will be with you. Jesus is both willing and eager to be with us where ever we are. Create the situation and invite Him. I'm sure He will be in your midst.


