Lucy's observation reminded of a similar trifecta from a few years back, when Pope Francis, Cardinal Francis George, and Fr. Francis Li were all simultaneously active in ministry. These two namesake observations help me to celebrate The Feast of the Holy Trinity and Father's Day today.

The Most Blessed Trinity and fatherhood each reflect a mystery. The meaning that sustains both of these mysteries can only be observed, never owned. Uncovering meaning happens incrementally, and observations come to the surface slowly during Christ's time. The name the Greeks give this divine time is *Kairos*. The closest description for my experience of *Kairos* in the life of the Trinity and in fatherhood comes from nature, where flowers slowly bloom. Just like how the world moves according to God's schedule, so too must we learn of the meaning of these mysteries in God's time.

And speaking of nature, thank you John and Sheila Lin for cultivating our garden.

May God bless each of you on this glorious feast day! Happy Father's Day to all our fathers!

Dear Parishioners of St. Barbara and St. Therese,

Easter Season blessings and unity greetings to you and your loved ones!

With unanimous support from all Unification Council Members, we have completed the work necessary to provide us with a Mass Schedule for our new Parish that will be effective July 1. We will monitor the Mass schedule and adjust, if necessary, based on the spiritual needs of the community after a year.

Existing Mass schedules were reviewed for both Parishes. Currently eight (8) Masses are offered each weekend, with 2 daily Masses between the two Parishes Mon-Sat. The unification team has prayerfully considered many critical points including traditions, special needs of the faith communities, along with current attendance at each Mass.

We are blessed with the ability to use two beautiful sanctuaries, located close to one another and encourage everyone to worship at both. Masses have been combined and located across our unified parish, with the goal of full pews and a vibrant spiritual energy. The 5pm Sunday Vigil Masses will be combined to a 5pm Mass at St. Barbara site. All pre-requested Mass intentions for the 5pm Sunday Vigil Mass at St. Therese will be transferred to the 5pm vigil Mass at St. Barbara site unless you call the parish office to make other arrangements. The 9:30am Mass and 11:30am Mass on Sunday morning at St. Barbara will be combined to a 9:30am Mass at St. Barbara and the pre-requested Mass intentions for the 11:30am Mass will be transferred to the 9:30am Mass unless you call the parish office to make other arrangements. There will be one weekday Mass rotated between the two worship sites. The worship schedule offered is forward looking to create a renewed spiritual and evangelical focused Parish reality.

So the following new Mass times at each worship site are scheduled to take effect following the unification on July 1st, 2019.

St. Barbara Church

Weekends: Sunday Vigil: 5:00 PM
Sunday: 6:00 AM & 9:30AM

Weekdays: 8:00 AM Mass on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays

St. Therese Church

Weekends: Sunday 8:00 AM & 10:30 AM & 12:00 PM (Twice a month)
Cantonese Mass, 1st Sunday, 10:30 AM; Indonesian Mass, 2nd Sunday, Noon; Mandarin Mass, 4th Sunday, Noon.

Weekdays: 8:00am Mass on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays

The Liturgy Committee will address details related to schedules and participation of servers, various ministries, including music, Feast Day Mass schedules, and locations.

School Mass schedule will be decided in July or August of 2019.

The schedule and location for Mandarin, Cantonese, and Indonesian Mass will be further evaluated in the next few months.

New Mass schedule reminders are planned for bulletins, websites, banners and signs.

We thank you for your prayers and support as we continue to journey on our calling together as pilgrims to build the exciting new reality the grace of our Lord offers each of us through Renew My Church.

"TRINITY Sunday" by Sister Caritas

There are many relationships in our lives. Some are long term relationships such as parents and child. Some are very brief such as the relationship as passenger and UBER driver. When the destination is reached and the bill is paid the relationship ends. Some relationships are ongoing lasting, permanent such as husband and wife (we hope, or precious friend).

Today's feast is about relationships. The mystery of the Trinity deals with relationships. Jesus, the Son of God, came to reveal who the Father was. He said, "Who has seen me has seen my Father", in the Gospel of John. In the same Gospel Jesus tells us that the Father and He are One. What is the Father's also is the Sons. The Father says He is well pleased and we are to listen to Jesus. The Holy Spirit is the expression of the great love the Father has for each other. The Holy Spirit, the Third person of the Trinity is sent out into the world, upon the Apostles and upon us to recreate us and the whole world.

So how does this mystery relate to us? The complete and total sharing of love and live in the Holy Trinity is a model and a goal we are to think about in intimate and important relationships in our lives. Do we hold back? Do we really care and share ourselves? Are we receptive to the gift of the other? Does our relationships give us life and creative energy to share with others and with the world around us? Does our love make the world a better place? The Trinity gives us life, lives in us and enlivens the world. How does this model fit into our parish, our lives, our city, country and the world? What can you and I do? Take chance. Risk to model your life on the Trinity.
